The description of the proposal is to request legislation prohibiting any new coal mining activity in the Eastern Slopes of Alberta's Rocky Mountains.

WHEREAS the Eastern Slopes of the province's Rocky Mountains are an area of natural beauty belonging to all Albertans and represent an area of watersheds and landscapes that are essential sources of clean water for drinking and food production.


WHEREAS coal mining in the Eastern Slopes would jeopardize the integrity of those areas and those sources of water.

WHEREAS companies continue to pursue approvals and permits for new coal mines and expansions of existing coal mines within the Eastern Slopes including the Grassy Mountain Project of Northback Holdings Corporation and the Blackstone Project of Valory Resources Inc.

WHEREAS the Government of Alberta defines the area of the Eastern Slopes in its Eastern Slopes Policy of 1977 (revised 1984 and 2023) as depicted in attached map.

Therefore I, Corby Lund, propose a legislative petition on the following question:

"The Government of Alberta shall prohibit through legislation all coal exploration and mining activities within the Eastern Slopes of Alberta's Rocky Mountains, other than mines that are in actual production as of January 1, 2026. For clarity, this prohibition includes Northback Holdings' Grassy Mountain Project and Valory Resources' Blackstone Project as well as any projects to expand any producing mines."
