- 1. The recall petition canvassing period begins the day the petition is issued and ends the last day of signing, or the day the signature sheets are submitted to the Chief Electoral Officer, if earlier. [Recall Act s. 1(1)(e)]
2. If the recall petition is discontinued or withdrawn, the recall petition canvassing period ends on the date the petition is discontinued or withdrawn. The prescribed financial reports are still required to be filed. [Recall Regulation s. 9(4)]
3. If the petition is successful, any surplus funds can be held in trust to be used for the purpose of the related recall vote. If the petition is unsuccessful, any surplus funds must be donated to a registered charity or returned to the relevant contributor(s) within 30 days after the end of the canvassing period. If the funds are not dealt with accordingly, they shall immediately be paid to the Chief Electoral Officer for deposit to the General Revenue Fund. [Recall Regulation s. 25]

- "Recall petition expense" means any expense incurred or non-monetary contribution received in relation to a recall petition, to the extent that the real property, goods or services that the expense was incurred for, or that were received as a non-monetary contribution, are used to directly promote the recall petition during the canvassing period. "Expense incurred" includes a recall petition expense that is incurred, whether it is paid or unpaid. [Recall Regulation s. 8(1), 8(2)]

Without limiting subsection (1), a recall petition expense includes an expense incurred for, or a non-monetary contribution in relation to, (a) the production of recall advertising, (b) the transmission, distribution, broadcast or publication of recall advertising in any media or by any other means during the canvassing period, including by the use of a capital asset, (c) the conduct or sponsorship of opinion surveys or other surveys or research during the canvassing period, (d) the payment of remuneration and expenses to or on behalf of an individual for the individual's services as a chief financial officer or in any other capacity, or (e) securing a meeting space. [Recall Regulation s. 8(3)]

A recall petition authorized participant shall not incur initiative petition expenses exceeding \$26,400, and includes expenses for individuals who canvass for signatures. [Recall Regulation s. 10]
