**NOTES**

1. If a prospective candidate does not, on or before the nomination day for an election under the *Election Act*, declare their candidacy as an independent candidate, and if the prospective candidate was not endorsed as a candidate of a registered party at the previous election, the prospective candidate association established for the prospective candidate must, no later than 7 days after the nomination day for the election, transfer the funds held by the prospective candidate association to one or more of the following, as applicable:
  - the registered party that proposed or supported the prospective candidate at the previous election or supported the prospective candidate after the previous election, or
  - a registered constituency association or registered candidate of the registered party that proposed or supported the prospective candidate at the previous election.

If surplus funds cannot be transferred in accordance with that any of the above, the prospective candidate association must transfer the funds to a registered charity. If a prospective candidate association has not complied with this section within 30 days of the date specified for the transfer of funds, the prospective candidate association must immediately transfer those funds to the Chief Electoral Officer, who must deposit those funds in the General Revenue Fund. [EFCDA s. 12.3]
2. LINE 12: Prospective candidate associations can pay election expenses on behalf of the party who has endorsed the prospective candidate of the PCA, and on behalf of the registered candidate. An expense used, consumed or distributed for promoting or opposing during the election period from Writ Day to Election Day is an "election expense".
