

When voting, you must show identification to prove your name and your current physical address.

Choose from one of the four ID options:

- 1** Present your **Alberta Driver's Licence** or **Alberta Identification Card** with your name and current physical address;
- 2** Show **two pieces of identification**, both with your name and with one piece showing your current physical address, from the list below:

- 3** If you are **unable to provide any identification** or **cannot confirm your current physical address**, you can be vouched for at the voting place by another registered elector in your voting area.
- 4** Your identity and physical address may also be established using an **Attestation Form** in lieu of having a vouching elector physically present at the voting place. Attestations Forms are signed by a person in a position of authority and are available for the following:
 - Incarcerated Electors
 - Student Electors In Residence
 - Indigenous Electors on Reserve or Settlement
 - Electors Receiving Services from Shelters or Community Support Centre
 - Electors on Mennonite or Hutterite Colony
 - Electors in Supportive Living or Long-Term Care
