Elections Alberta to launch mail-out enumeration program

EDMONTON – Elections Alberta will use the upcoming by-election in the Calgary-Glenmore electoral division to launch a mail-out enumeration initiative.

The enumeration notice will be mailed on July 27, 2009 and will encourage electors in Calgary-Glenmore to take an active role in maintaining the accuracy of their elector registration.

Electors are encouraged to make any necessary changes to their information on the notice and return it to Elections Alberta by August 18, 2009. Electors may also use the Voterlink program to update their records. Voterlink is hosted on the Elections Alberta website and helps electors to register for the first time or change their information online.

“This initiative is designed to further improve the quality of the Register of Electors, raise awareness about the by-election, and encourage civic participation by offering Albertans different ways to update their information,” says Elections Alberta spokesperson Drew Westwater.

Elections Alberta is an independent office of the Legislative Assembly that provides non-political administration of the electoral process.
