- Election Day
 - All municipalities
- Advance Voting
 - Municipalities with populations greater than 5000
- Special Ballot
- Institutional Voting

- Acclaimed Jurisdictions / Wards

Requirements

- Senate election and referendum vote is still conducted
- Election Day voting is provided
- Advance vote is provided if population exceeds 5000

- Municipality provides the ballots
- Composite ballot can be used
- Ballots must comply with legislated requirements
- Same ballot box can be used
- Senate election / referendum ballot retention period applies




- Ballot requirements:

 - Long ballots
 - Double-sided ballots
 - Two page ballots



Ballot Styles



VOTER TEMPLATE This template is for the use of those helping vision impaired voters who wish to mark their own ballot. Detach the ballot from the book:

> place a ballot into the template ensure that the bottom of the ballot is uniform with the bottom of the template and ensure that the white circles on

the ballot are clearly shown

through the holes of the template Reading from the bottom of the ballot, inform the elector of the order of the

mark the ballot with an 'X' in the circle opposite the name of the candidate of his or her choice remove the marked ballot from

candidate's name and political party or

independent status. Direct the elector to:

the template refold the ballot, and return the ballot to the deputy returning officer Ask the voter if he or she wishes to deposit the ballot in the ballot box.

- Unique to Senate & Referendum
- Requires ballot style and number of candidates / questions to be finalized




Voting Instructions Senate and Referendum

For <u>senate</u>, select up to **3** choices on the ballot.

For <u>referendum</u>, select only **1** response per question.



Any ballot marked in error may be exchanged for another.

Secrecy of Voting

Protect the Secrecy of the Vote:

- · Do not interfere with the voting process or collection of ballots,
- · Do not ask anyone how they plan to vote or have voted,
- · Do not attempt to view someone else's ballot,
- Do not take pictures of the ballot, and
- · Do not take selfies with the ballot.









 - Senate election ballot printing commences

Conduct Voting



- Eligible Electors:
 - 18+
 - Canadian Citizen
 - Resident in Alberta
 - Resident in the jurisdiction
- Electors may only have one place of residence for the purpose of voting
 - LAEA, s. 47 & 48



Timelines – Results Reporting



Post-Election

Custody of Records

- Election materials must be kept for 3-months after they are received from the returning officer
- Local jurisdictions are responsible for retaining the records



Post-Election

Judicial Recount



- Application for recount must be made by November 3, 2021
- Elections Alberta will make arrangements to collect Election Materials
 - Ballot boxes if using a paper ballot
 - Tabulator records and Ballot Account and Result of Vote if using alternative voting equipment
- Ballot retention period extends
