Elections Alberta launches a Register of Electors enhancement initiative

EDMONTON – Elections Alberta is conducting a residential address update initiative that will improve the accuracy of the Register of Electors and help to ensure that voters are directed to the correct polling stations at future elections.

The address/elector form was mailed on January 22, 2010 to 40,000 residences across Alberta to collect complete and up-to-date information.

Electors are encouraged to provide residential address information and elector information changes on the notice and return it to Elections Alberta. Electors may also use the Voterlink program, hosted on the Elections Alberta website, to register for the first time or change their information online.

“This initiative is designed to further improve the quality of the Register of Electors, and raise awareness of the need to keep election information current, while offering Albertans different ways to update their information” says Elections Alberta spokesperson Drew Westwater.

Elections Alberta is an independent office of the Legislative Assembly that provides non-political administration of the electoral process.
