Elections Alberta will begin a province-wide enumeration next month.

EDMONTON – Elections Alberta will be conducting a province-wide enumeration of electors from Friday, August 26, 2011 to Monday, September 19, 2011. Albertans will receive additional information through newspaper and radio advertisements, and by mail.

Enumerators will visit one million homes across Alberta to obtain current elector information in order to build a better List of Electors.

We are currently recruiting enumerators across Alberta. Any elector interested in working as an enumerator may visit our website www.elections.ab.ca to apply or get more information.

We encourage Albertans to take an active role in providing complete and accurate information to enumerators at their doors. Elector information is kept confidential and used to update the List of Electors in preparation for the next Provincial General Election.

Electors who are not at home during the enumeration period may use Voterlink to provide current elector information online. Voterlink is a secure online application hosted on the Elections Alberta website. Voterlink helps electors to register for the first time or to change their information any time of the day or night.
