# INTRODUCTION

## PURPOSE OF THIS GUIDE

This guide has been produced to assist the nomination contestant chief financial officer (CFO) with the preparation of financial disclosure forms including a campaign return, surplus distribution report, deficit retirement period financial statement, and all applicable schedules.

This guide is intended to be used in conjunction with the Nomination Contestant Guide to the Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act. All guides, registration and financial disclosure forms are available on the Elections Alberta website at [www.elections.ab.ca](http://www.elections.ab.ca).

Links to the *Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act* (EFCDA) and other relevant legislation are also available on the Elections Alberta website. Copies of provincial legislation may also be obtained from the Alberta Queen's Printer ([www.qp.alberta.ca](http://www.qp.alberta.ca)).

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## PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

All documents, including financial statements and registration documents, required to be filed with Elections Alberta by a nomination contestant become part of the public files and are available for public review. Financial statements are also posted on the Elections Alberta website at [www.elections.ab.ca](http://www.elections.ab.ca) under Parties, Candidates & Leadership Contests / Financial Disclosure.

# CAMPAIGN RETURN

This section contains information to assist the CFO to prepare the campaign return. Under section 43.01(1) of the EFCDA, the campaign return must include a financial statement, contribution report, campaign expense report and any supporting information / documents relating to the nomination contestant's campaign return. The following step-by-step instructions are for the Nomination Contestant Financial Statement form **NC-FS-01**.

## FINANCIAL STATEMENT

- Enter campaign period date range, starting with date the nomination contestant became registered with Elections Alberta, and ending two months after the conclusion of the nomination contest

### ► Fund-Raising Functions NC-FS-S01

- For each fund-raising function held:
  - Enter date of event
  - Enter brief description
  - Enter total amount of ticket/admission proceeds in “gross income” column
  - Enter portion of proceeds deemed as contribution revenue in “contribution portion” column
  - Subtract contribution portion from gross income and enter result in “net fund-raising income” column
- Sum total net fund-raising income column and enter amount on line 4 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

**Note:** Refer to the [Nomination Contestant Guide to the EFCDA](#) and section 23 of the EFCDA for information regarding the portion of a ticket or admission price that must be reported as a contribution.

### ► Transfer Detail NC-FS-S02

- For each transfer received:
  - Enter date the transfer was received
  - Enter name of registered party, registered constituency association, registered nomination contestant, or registered leadership contestant that issued the transfer
  - Enter amount of the transfer
- Sum total transfers received and enter amount on line 5 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)
- For each transfer issued:
  - Enter date the transfer was issued
  - Enter name of the registered party, registered constituency association, registered nomination contestant, or registered leadership contestant that received the transfer
  - Enter amount of the transfer
- Sum total transfers issued and enter amount on line 12 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

► **Other Income NC-FS-S03**

- For other income received that has not been reported on lines 1 to 5 of the financial statement:
  - Enter date the income was received
  - Enter source of the income
  - Enter nature of the income
  - Enter amount of the income
- Sum total other income and enter amount on line 6 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

**Note:** “Other Income” may include:

- anonymous contributions of \$50 or less
- collections from general meetings (the gross amount not reduced by expenses)
- interest earned on investments and/or bank deposits
- selling price of any goods and services sold (e.g. pins, buttons, etc.)
- any other funds collected of \$50 or less for which contribution receipts were **not** issued

► **Fees and Deposits NC-FS-S04**

- For each fee or deposit:
  - Enter date the fee or deposit was paid
  - Enter brief description
  - Enter name of the political party or other entity the fee or deposit was paid to
  - Enter amount of the fee or deposit
- Sum total fees / deposits and enter amount on line 10 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

**Note:** See the [Nomination Contestant Guide to the EFCDA](#) for more information regarding fees and deposits.

► **Election Expenses Subject to Spending Limit - Summary Schedule NC-FS-S05**

- Enter sub-total for each expense type, as determined by completing a detailed sub-schedule for each applicable expense type
- Sum total all expense types and enter amount on line 10 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

- Sum total expenses, and enter amount on line 11 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

**Note:** See the [Nomination Contestant Guide to the EFCD](#) for more information regarding expenses which are not subject to the spending limit.

► **Accounts Receivable NC-FS-S07**

- For any amounts owed to the nomination contestant’s campaign and not yet received as at the end of the campaign period:
  - Enter date the receivable was incurred by the debtor
  - Enter name of the debtor
  - Enter brief description of the receivable
  - Enter amount of the receivable
- Sum total accounts receivable and enter amount on line 19 of financial statement (NC-FS-01)

► **Other Assets at Cost NC-FS-S08**

- For other assets that have not been reported on lines 17 to 20 of the financial statement:
  - Enter date the asset was acquired / received
  - Enter brief description
  - Enter purchase price / value of the asset
- Sum total other assets and enter amount on line 21 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

**Note:** Examples of other assets may include membership shares in a credit union or contributions received but not yet deposited as at the end of the nomination contest campaign period.

► **Terms and Details of Loans NC-FS-S09**

- Enter total number of loans
- Enter total amount owing on all outstanding loans as at the end of the campaign period, and enter the amount on line 23 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)
- For each loan:
  - Enter name and address of the lender
  - Enter original loan amount
  - Enter total interest accrued to date
  - Enter total payments made
  - Enter current balance owing
  - Enter terms
  - Enter guarantor details including amount(s) guaranteed, guarantor name(s) and address(es)
  - Enter payment details including date(s) and amount(s) paid, payer name(s) and address(es)

**Note:** See [Nomination Contestant Guide to the EFCD](#) for more information regarding loans from financial institutions.

► **Accounts Payable NC-FS-S10**

- For any invoices from suppliers that were not yet paid by the nomination contestant's campaign as at the end of the campaign period:
  - Enter date of the invoice
  - Enter name of the supplier
  - Enter brief description the good or service
  - Enter amount of the invoice
- Sum total accounts payable and enter amount on line 24 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

► **Debts Incurred But Not Yet Billed NC-FS-S11**

- For any debts owing to suppliers that were not yet billed (invoiced) as at the end of the campaign period:
  - Enter date the debt was incurred
  - Enter name of the supplier
  - Enter brief description of the good or service
  - Enter amount owed / yet to be billed (invoiced)
- Sum total debts incurred but not yet billed and enter amount on line 25 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

► **Other Liabilities NC-FS-S12**

- For any liabilities (financial obligations) that were outstanding as at the end of the campaign period and have not been reported on lines 23 to 25:
  - Enter date the liability was incurred
  - Enter name of the supplier
  - Enter brief description
  - Enter amount of the liability
- Sum total other liabilities and enter amount on line 26 of the financial statement (NC-FS-01)

# SURPLUS DISTRIBUTION REPORT

This section contains information to assist the CFO to prepare a surplus distribution report, when there are surplus funds held at the end of the nomination contest campaign period. This report provides a means for the CFO to provide confirmation to Elections Alberta that it has complied with the requirements under section 12.1 of the EFCDA with regard to the disbursement of surplus funds. The following step-by-step instructions are for the Nomination Contestant Surplus Distribution Report form **NC-SDR-01**.

## ► HEADER INFORMATION (Pages 1 & 2)

- Enter date range, starting on day *after* the filing deadline for the nomination contestant campaign return and ending 30 days after that date
- Enter name of the registered nomination contestant, name of the registered political party and name of the electoral division
- Enter filing deadline date for the nomination contestant campaign return (4 months after the conclusion of the nomination contest)
- Enter filing deadline date for the surplus distribution report (30 days after the campaign return filing deadline date)

Under section 43.1 of the EFCDA, any contributions accepted and any transfers received to eliminate the campaign deficit must be shown. The following step-by-step instructions are for the Nomination Contestant Deficit Retirement Period Financial Statement form **NC-DS-01**.
